

Sight Word Activity Ideas:

- Flash Cards: repetition is key since they can't sound these words out so grab some index cards and make a colorful flash card set to practice the words
- Sight Word Hunt: Tape, or hide sight word cards up around your house and have your child "hunt" for the word and write the word down on a piece of paper
- Copy: Make copies of sight word flash cards so that you can make a memory or go fish game with them (you should have 2 of each word).
- House Traffic: Put sight words up on stair railing or somewhere where there is high traffic in the house. Every time your child passes by they will see the words, you can even remind them to say the words each time they pass by.
- Read to a Friend: Have your child read the set of cards to a stuffed animal or a friend
Basically, make sure they are reading the sight words for the week EVERY DAY!
